The Minister's determination is requested under Section 69(2)(a) of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act, 1997 in relation to the revocation of Fish Culture Licence No 71.

Executive summary

The Minister's determination is requested in relation to the revoking of Fish Culture Licence No. 71 (Ref T09/084) from Frank Burke, Rafford, Kiltulla, Athenry, Co. Galway under Section 69(2)(a) of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act 1997.

It is recommended that the Minister approves the revocation for the reasons outlined in the 'Detailed Information' section below.

Detailed information

Background

Fish Culture Licence No. 71 was granted to Frank Burke, Rafford, Kiltulla, Athenry, Co. Galway on 3rd November 1981 for the cultivation of rainbow trout at Rafford, Athenry, Co. Galway (**TAB A**). The licence does not have an expiration date.

Correspondence issued to the licensee advising him that revocation of the licence was under consideration and requesting any submissions that the licensee wished to make on his behalf on 9 August 2023 (TAB B). Proof of Delivery of this correspondence is attached (TAB F). No response was received from the Mr. Burke.

Section 69(2)(a) of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act 1997 states,

- '(a) Subject to paragraph (b), where aquaculture in respect of which a licence has been granted has ceased for a continuous period of 2 years, the Minister shall, without compensation to the licensee, revoke the licence.
- (b) A licensee who considers that there are exceptional reasons why aquaculture, in respect of which a licence has been granted to the licensee, has ceased or is likely to cease for the period referred to in in paragraph (a), may apply to the Minister, giving those reasons, for a determination not to revoke the licence.
- (c) The Minister may, in his or her discretion, having considered the reasons given by the licensee under

paragraph (b), determine whether or not to revoke the licence. The determination of the Minister is final.'

Technical Consultation

The Department's Engineering Division confirmed on 20 July 2023 that there was no aquaculture activity on the site, and it appeared the site had not been used for some years (**TAB C**). Marine Engineering Division had previously visited the site on 13 December 2021 and had noted that the "facility is in poor condition and does not appear to have been operating for some time." (**TAB D**)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Minister approve the revocation of Fish Culture Licence No 71. If approved the revocation will proceed as outlined in Section 21 of SI 236/1998 - Aquaculture (Licence Application) Regulations, 1998 (as amended) and a certificate of revocation will issue to Mr. Burke (TAB E).

- 1 No fish other than rainbow trout shall be bred and handled at the said fish farm.
- The licensee shall provide and maintain such gratings or other devices in the intake and discharge channels as will effectually prevent the admission of migratory fish into the other water courses and ponds of the fish farm, and make adequate arrangements to ensure the safe passage past the farm of migratory fish and shall make all necessary provisions to prevent the escape of rainbow trout from the ponds and water courses of the farm and shall carry out any instructions issued in this connection from time to time by the Minister for Fisheries and Forest:
- Abstraction of water shall be so regulated that sufficient water will be maintained at all times in the natural water courses adjoining the farm to ensure the free passage of migratory fish past the farm. - Such precautions shall be taken as the Minister for Fisheries may specify from time to time, in relation to (a) introductions of rainbow trout ova or fry for stocking the farm, including disease free certification, in appropriate terms, and (b) the adaptation of methods of operation or type of installation (e.g. use of concrete ponds).
