We do not understand why our site application was refused,

Our site application was refused for the following reasons,

Increased negative visual impact;

Megative impact on the existing licensed sites in the harbour

However site application number T06/360A was granted a licence even though it right next to our site and to add injury to insult we believe part of our site (T06/254) may have even been used to facilitate the granting of Site T06/360A.

Our application was in many years before T06/360A.

We have a very small existing site of six hectors while Kush have over 50 hectors at least of existing granted sites.

This site would be very useful to use as it's next to our existing granted licence and would make our farm more viable.

Why would Site T06/360A be granted and Site T06/254 not be granted.
