# AQUACULTURE LICENCES APPEALS BOARD

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## **CHAIRMAN'S STATEMENT to the Minister** for the Marine and Natural Resources

Wit h the conclusion of another year's work at the Aquaculture Licences Appeals Board, I am pleased, once again, to include my Chairman's Statement in the Board's 4th Annual Report.

The beginning of the year saw the Board move into its new office premises located on the 3rd floor of Holbrook House, Holles Street, Dublin 2. This was a very welcome event, not only for the convenience of the board members and the Secretariat, but more importantly to demonstrate the statutory independence of the Board. I would like to Conor J. Maguire, S.C. thank all those who were involved in both the organization and Chairman preparation of the work required at all stages of this undertaking which, undoubtedly required an amount of time and effort by many individual parties. The opening of our new offices also allowed for an access facility to the public if the need arises in relation to the handing in of appeals directly to the office by any member of the public.

As the year progressed, we expanded our facilities to the public in terms of access to information in relation to decisions made by the Board etc., by acquiring our own web site, which I am confident will be a useful tool as a source of information. Our web site address can be found on the page following this statement. The Secretariat is continuing to develop the information provided on the site and this will be updated on an on-going basis.

This year also saw the approach of the end of the 3-year appointment period for each of the six board members on 29th June, 2001. In response, the Minister re-appointed each member for a period of one additional year to 29 June, 2002. I, on behalf of the Board also met with the Minister on two occasions during the year, as provided for under the Act, to discuss issues of mutual interest and to allow an opportunity for an exchange of views with regard to various aspects of the aquaculture industry and the licensing procedure. Meetings of this nature I believe are always useful from time to time, as they were on these occasions.

We also had a number of changes during the year at both Board membership level as well as Secretariat level.

Firstly, with regard to changes in the Board membership – Ms Berna Grist, Deputy Chairperson resigned from the Board on 30th September, 2001 to take up a post at An Bord Pleanála. I know I speak on behalf of all the Board members in wishing Berna every success in her new post and to thank her for her valuable contributions during her term with the Board, both as a member and in her role as Deputy Chairperson. Her post was filled by Dr Ann Quinn, previously Deputy Chairperson of An Bord Pleanála, who was appointed with effect from 12 November, 2001 to 29 June, 2003. Dr Quinn is most welcome to the Board and will no doubt bring a considerable amount of experience to it over the coming year.

Secondly, with regard to the changes in the Board's Secretariat - Mr Eugene Nixon was appointed as the Board's Technical Inspector on 2 January, 2001. Mr Nixon was previously employed as a senior chemist with the Marine Institute. His appointment was a very welcome one, not just in relation to the necessity for such specialized staffing, but also to ensure the continued delivery of a fair and effective process with regard to Board determinations. Mr Nixon's contribution to the workings of the Board has been invaluable. In addition, Ms Eileen O'Connor joined the secretariat of the Board whose contribution and assistance has also been most valuable.

An ot her important change that took place during the year was the introduction of new legislation by the Minister for the Marine and Natural Resources, namely, the Fisheries (Amendment) Act, 2001. This

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

# **AQUACULTURE LICENCES APPEALS BOARD**

The following is some general information regarding the Aquaculture Licences Appeals Board. However, to obtain an overall picture as to how the appeal process as well as the aquaculture licensing system operates, reference should be made to the Fisheries (Amendment) Act, 1997 and also the most recently introduced legislation, the Fisheries (Amendment) Act, 2001.

### ESTABLISHMENT OF BOARD

The Aquaculture Licences Appeals Board was established on 17 June, 1998 under Section 22 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act, 1997. All Board members are engaged on a part-time basis.

#### **FUNCTION**

The function of the Board is to provide an independent authority for the determination of appeals against decisions of the Minister for the Marine and Natural Resources on aquaculture licences. A person aggrieved by a decision of the Minister on an aquaculture licence application, or by the revocation or amendment of an aquaculture licence, may make an appeal within one month of publication (in the case of a decision) or notification (in the case of revocation/amendment).

### **STATUS**

The Board is an independent body with its own funding provided for by the Oireachtas under Section 36 of the Act.

#### **MEMBERSHIP OF BOARD**

Under Section 23 of the Act, the Board consists of a Chairman and six other members. The Chairman, a senior counsel, was appointed by the Government for a term of 5 years effective from 30 June, 1998. The other six members were appointed by the Minister for the Marine and Natural Resources for a term of three years effective from 30 June, 1998. All six were re-appointed for a period of one year from 30 June, 2001, by Mr Frank Fahey, T.D., Minister for the Marine and Natural Resources.

Ms Berna Grist, Deputy Chairperson resigned from the Board on 30 September, 2001, while Dr Ann Quinn was appointed by Mr Frank Fahey, T.D., Minister for the Marine and Natural Resources effective from 12 November, 2001 to 29 June, 2003.

### **COMPOSITION OF BOARD**

In accordance with Section 23(3) of the Act, the Minister for the Marine and Natural Resources made regulations prescribing not less than two organisations representative of each of the following groupings:

- (a) organisations concerned with the promotion of the development of aquaculture or representative of persons carrying on the business of developing aquaculture;
- (b) organisations concerned with the conservation, development and protection of wild fisheries;
- (c) organisations representative of persons whose professions or occupations relate to physical planning and development;
- (d) organisation representative of persons concerned with the protection and preservation of the environment and amenities;

- (e) organisations representative of persons concerned with the promotion of general economic development and
- (f) organisations representative of persons concerned with the promotion of community development.

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES**

The main responsibilities and powers of the Board are set out below:

Under Section 40(4) of the Act, on receipt of an appeal by the Board and provided it is not withdrawn, the Board can determine the appeal by

- (a) confirming the decision or action of the Minister
- (b) determining the application for the licence as if the application had been made to the Board in the first instance or
- (c) in relation to the revocation or amendment of a licence, substituting its decision on the matter for that of the Minister.

Under Section 43 of the Act, the Board must send a copy of the notice of appeal to the Minister and to each other party to the appeal;

Under Section 46 of the Act, the Board can request submissions or observations from parties or other persons who have already made submissions or observations to the Board in relation to an appeal, if, in the opinion of the Board and in the circumstances, it is in the interests of justice to do so;

Under Section 47 of the Act, the Board can request documents, particulars or other information it considers necessary for the purpose of enabling it to determine an appeal;

Under *Section* 49 of the Act, the Board has the absolute discretion to hold an oral hearing of an appeal;

Under Section 56 of the Act, the Board shall ensure that appeals are dealt with and determined expeditiously and that all steps are taken to avoid unnecessary delays.

#### **CONSULTANTS AND ADVISERS**

Under Section 35 of the Act, the Board may engage consultants or advisers as it considers necessary for the performance of its functions. Fees due to either are paid by the Board out of moneys made available by the Oireachtas. The Board did not engage consultants or advisers during 2001.

#### **SECRETARIAT**

Under Section 32 of the Act, an officer of the Minister who is an established civil servant and who is seconded to the Board for that purpose, either on a whole-time or part-time basis, shall act as Secretary to the Board. There has been no change to date with regard to the Secretary to the Board.





#### **APPEALS RECEIVED**

In 2001, the Board received a total of 76 appeals, representing an increase of approximately 50% in the level of appeals received over numbers received in 2000.

However, and in addition to the 76 received in 2001, there were a total of 22 appeals awaiting decision from 2000, giving a grand total of 98 appeals for determination. The 76 appeals received represented 55 Ministerial licence decisions from a total of approximately 100 Ministerial decisions made in 2001.

Of the 76 received in 2001, 21 were in relation to Salmon licences, representing 28% of total appeals received. This compares with 24% received in 2000. The balance of appeals received in 2001 related to oysters, mussels and one in relation to abalone.

#### **JUDICIAL REVIEW**

In accordance with Section 73 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act, 1997, a person can apply for judicial review of determinations of the Board by way of an application for judicial review, provided it is made within the period of three month commencing on the date on which the determination was made. During 2001, three applications had been made to the courts against three of the Board determinations in 1999 and 2001. Two of these applications have been ruled on, with the results being in favour of the Board's decisions, while the third is still awaiting decision. Details of these applications are as follows:

- a) The first application was in relation to a Board decision dated 17th July, 1999, in respect of the cultivation of oysters on Woodstown Strand, Co Waterford. The case was heard on 1st February, 2001, with the court ruling in favour of the Board;
- b) The second application was in relation to a Board decision dated 10th April, 2001 in respect of the granting of an aquaculture licence to Cuan Baoi Sea Farms Ltd, c/o Eir Nor Teoranta, Ballyhea, Dingle, Co Kerry for the cultivation of salmon in Bantry Bay, Co Cork. Following a hearing on 30th July, 2001, the court ruled in favour of the Board and awarded costs;

c) The third application was in relation to a Board decision dated 21st January, 2001 in respect of the granting of an aquaculture licence to Bannow Bay Fisheries, Clifton, Spawell Road, Wexford for the cultivation of oysters at Bannow Bay, Co Wexford. This case is waiting a date to be assigned for hearing.

### **SUMMARY OF DETERMINATIONS**

The Board made a total of 38 determinations in 2001, representing 57 of the appeals received. This resulted in the granting of 14 aquaculture licences in total, of which 5 were in respect of salmon. A map representing licences issued is on page 10.

The Board also (i) agreed with one of the licence decisions granted by the Minister of State at the Department of the Marine and Natural Resources (ii) refused or upheld four aquaculture licences appealed and (iii) overturned the decision of the Minister in respect of one case where the licensee was refused a licence and therefore upheld this appeal also.

### **DETAILS OF APPEALS RECEIVED AND DETERMINATIONS MADE IN 2001**

Under Section 40(4) of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act, 1997, the Board, in determining the appeals has the option of:

- (i) confirming the decision of the Minister to grant or refuse a licence or
- (ii) determining and issuing its own aquaculture licence as if the application for the licence had been made to the Board in the first instance.

Where the Board determined that it wished to alter the terms or conditions of a licence decision granted by the Minister, it did so by issuing its own licence with additional or altered terms and conditions.
