Any such submissions or observations will be considered by the planning authority in making a decision on the application. The planning authority may grant permission subject to or without conditions or may refuse to grant permission.

You should always take note of a public notice. It is a legal notice to inform the public of a change that could affect them short term or on a permanent basis. It could be anything from a change to a building to the erection of a building. It could be notice of insolvency of a company you have dealings with or the closure of a footpath that you regularly use.
