#### **Extracts from Act**

**40.**—(1) A person aggrieved by a decision of the Minister on an application for an aquaculture licence or by the revocation or amendment of an aquaculture licence may, before the expiration of a period of one month beginning on the date of publication in accordance with this Act of that decision, or the notification to the person of the revocation or amendment, appeal to the Board against the decision, revocation or amendment, by serving on the Board a notice of appeal.

(2) A notice of appeal shall be served—

(a) by sending it by registered post to the Board,

(b) by leaving it at the office of the Board, during normal office hours, with a person who is apparently an employee of the Board, or

(c) by such other means as may be prescribed.

(3) The Board shall not consider an appeal notice of which is received by it later than the expiration of the period referred to in subsection (1)

41.-(1) For an appeal under section 40 to be valid, the notice of appeal shall-

(a) be in writing,

(b) state the name and address of the appellant,

(c) state the subject matter of the appeal,

(d) state the appellant's particular interest in the outcome of the appeal,

(e) state in full the grounds of the appeal and the reasons, considerations and arguments on which they are based, and

(*f*) **be accompanied by such fee**, if any, as may be payable in respect of such an appeal in accordance with regulations under *section 63*, and

shall be accompanied by such documents, particulars or other information relating to the appeal as the appellant considers necessary or appropriate.

I wish to appeal the Minister's decision to refuse to grant an aquaculture and foreshore licence T6-373A on the following reasons

- Small local sustainable application: My application is for an area of 4 Ha within Castlemaine Harbour. My home place overlooks Castlemaine Harbour and the area I have applied for to cultivate oysters and mussels.
- Integrity of SAC and SPA. My site application of 4 Ha will not affect the integrity of the SAC or SPA in Castlemaine Harbour. The area applied for is so small that no effect could be had on SAC or SPA.
- Consideration/Assessment of Licence application as part block of 100 applications/reviews. My licence application T6-373A was considered and assessed as a block of over 100 aquaculture licence applications reviews. My licence is for a small sustainable area within the Harbour and was not considered on its own merit individually.
- 4. Benefits to Locality. The licencing of this site will have many benefits for a rural coastal community including direct revenue from oyster and mussel sales. Licencing of the site will ensure that I can work in the community we I was born and raised.
